## Victory over Otago University

On the 27th of March LURFC sent two senior sides down to Pleasant Point to play against Otago University RFC. It was a gala day with Canterbury University also playing their southern rivals in colts and women's rugby. This arrangement allowed selectors to identify potential NZ University players.

The A side took on Varsity A in a tough encounter at the domain. The extra matches that the majority of players have had in Australia helped the team get into rhythm quickly. As a result we dominated the possession stakes and were clinical at set play, especially in line outs.

Going into the break with a 17 - 13 lead enabled our inside backs to produce some smart tactical kicking that allowed us to play a structured game plan. The end result saw Lincoln beat Otago for the first time in many years 31 - 23.

Tries were scored by **Cale Dobby**, **Shuan Hill (2)** and **Jesse Bright**. **Aaron Somerset** was accurate with the boot kicking 5 from 6 including a penalty and 4 conversions.

The Senior B side had a slow start with some uncharacteristic errors snuffing out good attacking opportunities. They collected themselves and began to implement a more patient pattern of play and soon found their rhythm. The team eventually won the match 28—18 which topped of a great day for Lincoln University Rugby.

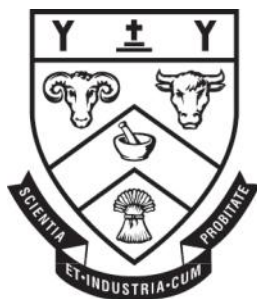
