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## Summary of regulations for students beginning this degree in 2018:

- At least 480 credits (32 courses)
- All the compulsory courses
- No more than 165 credits (11 courses) at the 100-level
- At least 105 credits (7 courses) at the 300-level
- At least 60 credits (4 courses) coded ANSC, FORS, HORT, PLSC, SOSC, WINE
- Complete practical work.

(Unless noted otherwise, each course is 15 credits)

## Suitable Electives for First Years:

At least 4 courses must be science courses (ie coded ANSC, FORS, HORT, PLSC, SOSC, WINE). It is strongly recommended that at least 2 are chosen from the courses listed here at the 100 level, and taken in Year 1, Semester 2.

- **ANSC 105 - Animal Science**
- **SOSC 106 - Soil Science 1**
- **PLSC 104 - Plant Science**

Other suggested electives:
