Summary of regulations for students beginning this degree in 2018:

(Unless noted otherwise, each course is 15 credits)

- At least 480 credits (32 courses)
- All the compulsory courses
- No more than 165 credits (11 courses) at the 100-level
- At least 75 credits (five courses) at the 300-level
- At least 120 credits (six courses) at the 600-level
- A minimum of **one** from List A (below)
- A minimum of **one** from List B (below)
- One of ERST 698 or ERST 699
- Must achieve a B+ average (or better) in the BEPP 300 level compulsory courses to enrol in the 600 level courses.
- Must achieve a B+ grade (or better) in SOCI 314.
