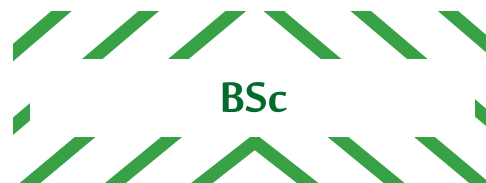

Individual major

This major enables you to create your own science major e.g. biochemistry, genetics, animal science or plant science. You may also be able to combine different disciplines e.g. ecology and soil science. Your major must have a focus and this is normally defined by a minimum of three 300-level courses with the same prefix. The prefix determines the broad subject area, e.g. Soil Science courses are prefixed SOSC. Check the Courses page on the website and discuss your plan with the Course Advisor. Your Course Advisor will help you choose the right first and second year courses to be able to take your selection of 300-level courses.

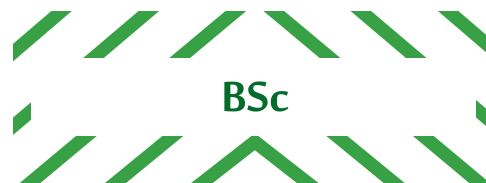

Summary of regulations for students beginning this degree in 2018:

(Unless noted otherwise, each course is 15 credits)

- At least 360 credits (24 courses)
- All the compulsory courses
- No more than 165 credits (11 courses) at the 100-level
- At least 75 credits (5 courses) at the 300-level
- Must have an area of focus (normally three 300-level courses with the same prefix)
- Complete **one** of List A.
