Semester dates

- 1st First semester: September – January - Blocks 1,2 and 3
- Second semester: February – June - Blocks 4,5 and 6

The academic year is split into six study periods. Each study period ends with an exam, after which the course is completed and new courses start with the new study period. Students can start or end any study period.

Accommodation

Exchange students can only be nominated for [housing](#) through the exchange coordinators. The number of available rooms for exchange students is very limited. Most students will need to find housing through the private market.

Insurance

Students are strongly advised to bring their own Health, Travel and Accident insurance policy. Non-Dutch students must be adequately insured for medical expenses while staying in the Netherlands. Academic and course information

30 ECTS are equal to 60 Lincoln University credits.

Most of the [courses](#) equal 6 ECTS units. The last two digits of the course code identify the number of credits.

WU offers programmes in life sciences, social sciences, environmental sciences and technology & nutrition.

All 3rd year undergraduate/BSc courses and many of the 2nd year undergraduate/BSc courses are taught in English.
