Colliers Rural and Agribusiness Valuation Scholarship

Regulations

1. Purpose

The Crighton Anderson Valuation Scholarship was established in 2013 to reward excellence and encourage students who wish to make a career in valuation and who undertake studies at Lincoln University.

The scholarship was rebranded as Colliers Rural and Agribusiness Valuation in April 2015.

2. Value

One scholarship to be offered annually to a full-time student studying in the Bachelor of Land and Property Management degree (BLPM) or Graduate Diploma in Valuation at Lincoln University.

The value of the scholarship is tuition fees up to the value of \$2,500 to a student in their third or fourth year of studies in 2021.

In addition, and provided suitable opportunities are available, Colliers may also offer the awardee paid internship or vacation work during the tenure of the award in our Rural & Agribusiness Valuation division.

3. Eligibility

Applicants must be full time students who are:

- (a) About to enter their third or fourth year of study towards a degree specialising in Valuation in the year following this application.
- (b) Studying rural valuation and with keen interest in primary sector will be favourably considered.
- (b) New Zealand Citizens or Permanent Residents.

4. Selection Criteria

The criteria for selection will be:

- (a) Academic merit
- (b) Interest in pursuing a career in valuation
- (c) Communication and interpersonal skills
- (d) Potential to succeed

5. Selection Committee

The scholarship shall be awarded based on a recommendation of a selection committee from representatives of Crighton Anderson Property and Infrastructure Ltd trading as Colliers, or nominees.

The selection committee may request the applicant to attend an interview as part of the selection process.

The selection committee may refrain from making an award if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.

6. Tenure

- (a) The scholarship is tenable for one year.
- (b) The scholarship is tenable with any other scholarship, award or bursary provided prior approval from Colliers Rural Valuation has been granted.
- (c) An internship with Colliers may also be available to the selected candidate.

7. Application
