

Colliers Otago Valuation Scholarship

Regulations

1. Purpose

Colliers Otago has established this scholarship in 2022 to encourage and reward excellence for students wishing to make a career in property valuation.

2. Number/Value

One scholarship will be offered annually to a full time student in their third or fourth year of study at Lincoln University and will be to a value of \$3,500 per year towards tuition fees.

In addition, and provided suitable positions are available, Colliers Otago may also offer the awardee paid internship or vacation work during the tenure of the award.

3. Eligibility

- (a) Applicants who have successfully passed their second year of study towards the Bachelor of Land and Property Management degree are eligible to apply.
- (b) Applicants must be New Zealand Citizens or Permanent Residents.
- (c) Applicants must be able to demonstrate a preference for a career in the property valuation sector.

4. Selection Criteria

The criteria for selection will be

- (a) Academic Merit
- (b) Communication and Interpersonal Skills
- (c) Potential to succeed
- (d) Extra-curricular activities or charitable endeavours

Candidates may be asked to attend an interview as part of the selection process.

5. **Selection Committee**

The scholarship shall be awarded based on the recommendation of a selection committee which shall comprise:

- The Convenor of the Scholarships Committee, or nominee
- An academic with experience in the property sector
- A representative from Colliers Otago.

The selection committee may refrain from making an award if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.

6. **Tenure**

- (a) The scholarship is tenable for one year.
- (b) The scholarship shall be tenable with any other scholarship, bursary or award unless the conditions of the other award preclude it.
- (c) An internship with Colliers Otago may also be made available to the selected candidate. Colliers Otago have offices in Dunedin, Wanaka and Queenstown.
