



Constellation Brands Scholarship 2024

Regulations

1. Summary

The Constellation Brands Scholarship was established in 2012 and supports a student who is entering their second or third year of study towards a Bachelor of Viticulture and Oenology degree at Lincoln University

2. Number/Value

One annual scholarship of \$5,000 will be offered to a full-time student studying at Lincoln University to go towards tuition fees or living expenses.

The applicant will be given an opportunity to work at least one Vintage at a Constellation Brands winery in the Marlborough region within the year of the scholarship or the following year (work will be paid at the living wage and otherwise on agreed terms). Constellation Brands will also provide mentoring to the successful applicant as well as the opportunity to undertake other work experience over the summer holidays.

3. Eligibility

- (a) Applicants must be full time students registered in their second or third year of their Bachelor of Viticulture and Oenology degree.
- (b) Applicants must be New Zealand Citizens or Permanent Residents.

4. Selection Criteria

The criteria for selection will be

- (a) Academic Merit
- (b) Evidence of and/or planned activity to support the New Zealand wine industry

5. Selection Committee

The scholarship shall be awarded based on a recommendation of a selection committee which shall comprise:

- The convenor of the Scholarships Committee, or nominee
- Two representatives from Constellation Brands NZ.

The selection committee may request the applicant to attend an interview as part of the selection process.

The selection committee may refrain from making an award if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.

6. What will you receive

- (a) As well as the payment you will receive one-on-one mentoring sessions with a representative from Constellation Brands or an Aligned Industry Partner during the 2023 semester. This can and may include an invitation to spend time at a Constellation Brands' winery to assist in your research and assignment tasks.
- (b) Occasional invitations to industry events in alignment with Constellation Brands or their Industry Partners to provide you the opportunity to build industry relationships and gain insight into the industry.

7. Tenure

- (a) The scholarship is tenable for one year.
- (b) The scholarship is tenable with any other scholarship, award or bursary.

Note: Upon successful completion of the qualification Constellation Brands NZ may offer an internship should the opportunity become available.

8. Application

9. The award of the scholarship may be acknowledged in media and marketing material by both NMIT and Constellation Brands.
