First Light Foods Scholarship

Regulations

1. Purpose

The First Light Foods Scholarship was established in 2013 to provide financial assistance to students who wish to undertake studies in area of Supply Chain Management at Lincoln University and who plan to make a career in a Land Based Industry.

2. Number/Value

One scholarship may be offered annually to a full time student studying at Lincoln University. The value of the scholarship is \$5000 and is tenable for one year.

3. Eligibility

- (a) Applicants must be full time students who have successfully completed their first year of study towards any degree with a Supply Chain component.
- (b) Applicants may be New Zealand Citizens, Permanent Residents or International students.

4. Selection Criteria

The criteria for selection will be:

- (a) Relevance of selected degree to Supply Chain Management.
- (b) Academic merit
- (c) Future career plans to contribute to New Zealand's agribusiness and food industries.

5. Selection Committee

The scholarship shall be awarded based on a recommendation of a selection committee which shall comprise:

- The convenor of the Scholarships Committee, or nominee
- A member of the Lincoln University Scholarships Committee, and
- A representative from First Light Foods, or nominee.

The selection committee may require the applicant to attend an interview as part of the selection process.

The selection committee may refrain from making an award if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.

6. Tenure

- (a) The scholarship is tenable for one year provided the applicant maintains agreed academic standards.
- (b) The scholarship is tenable with any other scholarship, award or bursary provided prior approval from First Light Foods has been granted.

Note: An acceptable academic standard is defined as having passed eight courses at an average of a B grade over two academic semesters.
