To be eligible to apply for this scholarship, you must:

- Be a citizen or permanent resident of Aotearoa | New Zealand
- Be enrolled in a full-time undergraduate, postgraduate or research programme at Lincoln University, and in the final semester / year of your qualification.
- Be a woman (assigned female at birth and/or self-identify as female)

Priority may be given to applicants who are Māori and/or Pasifika.

- Include a personal statement to reflect the personal circumstances that make you a candidate for this scholarship, e.g., provide details of how this assistance will support you to achieve your goals.
- Provide evidence of expected costs that would be covered by the scholarship.
