## THE JOHN MOWBRAY HOWARD TRIPP

## AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP

This award was established under the will of the late Mrs Mary H Tripp and is intended to recognise students enrolled in land based degree programmes at Lincoln University who come from the Canterbury region. The award honours the memory of John Mowbray Howard Tripp whose family has farmed in the Geraldine district for more than 150 years.

## **Regulations:**

- 1. The award shall be known as the John Mowbray Howard Tripp Agricultural Scholarship.
- 2. One scholarship is available annually to a full time student of Lincoln University enrolled in any programme related to land based industries, who has studied at any secondary school in the Canterbury land district for at least three years.
- 3. Preference may be given to applicants who are within two years of completing their studies for the degree programme for which they are enrolled.
- 4. The criteria for selection will be:
  - 4.1 leadership potential;
  - 4.2 future contribution to New Zealand land based industries; and
  - 4.3 academic merit.
- 5. The value of the scholarship will be reviewed annually by the selection committee. The current maximum value of the Scholarship is \$1,200.
- 6. The period of tenure is one year. Previous holders of the award may apply for the award in a subsequent year.
- 7. The scholarship may be awarded by a Selection Committee of three members comprising:
  - a member of the Tripp family or nominee who shall chair the committee;
  - a staff member teaching into programmes associated with land based industries;
  - the Convenor of the Lincoln University Scholarships Committee or nominee.
- 8. Application forms are available from the Lincoln University website www.lincoln.ac.nz/scholarships, with whom applications close on 31 May each year.
