

LINCOLN UNIVERSITY

THE JAMES AND EVELYN GANE SCHOLARSHIP

Established by the late Miss Grace Margaret Gane, Speech Therapist of Christchurch who died on the 6th day of May 2003.

Regulations

1. Purpose

The late Miss Grace Gane provided funds to set up this Scholarship Fund in memory of her grandfather James Gane who farmed in Marlborough and in memory of her mother Evelyn Edith Gane. In her will she wanted the funds to be given to Lincoln University to enable the University to offer scholarships to students who intend to take up farming, horticulture or similar as a career.

The scholarships will be known as the James and Evelyn Gane Scholarships.

2. Number/Value

2.1 One scholarship will be made annually and will be tenable for up to five (5) years.

2.2 The scholarship shall be for an adequate amount as determined by the University Council but should initially be \$5,000 per annum.

3. Eligibility

3.1 Applicants must be about to enrol in their first year of an undergraduate degree or diploma at Lincoln University and have gained a University Entrance qualification in New Zealand or an international equivalent within two (2) years of applying.

3.2 Applicants must be from a rural background and intend to study a degree or diploma that will allow them to take up farming, horticulture or similar as a career.

3.3 The applicants must be over the age of 16 at the date of awarding the scholarship and must have lived continuously in New Zealand for at least three (3) consecutive years.

4. Selection Criteria

4.1 The applicant should show a pronounced talent according to the testimony of two (2) persons who are competent judges including one from the applicant's school.

4.2 The candidate must be of good character.

4.3 Consideration should be given to the financial needs of the applicants, subject to all of the other conditions being met.

5. Selection Committee

The scholarship shall be awarded by the Vice-Chancellor on the recommendation of the selection committee that shall comprise:

- (a) The Vice-Chancellor, or nominee
- (b) One nominee from the Gane family, currently Dr Adrian Gane,
- (c) One member of the University Alumni Association,
- (d) One nominee from the Lincoln University scholarship committee.

If in the opinion of the selection committee there is no suitable applicant it may recommend no award being made.

6. Co-Tenure

6.1 The scholarship may be held with any other award unless the conditions of the other award preclude it. Provided that in all cases Lincoln University may require the recipient to pay all or part of his or her tuition fees from the funds available to the recipient from any other award. For the purposes of these regulations an award includes a scholarship, bursary, prize or fellowship.

6.2 The scholarship may be terminated by the Vice-Chancellor at any time on receipt of a report from the Lincoln University Scholarships Committee that the conduct and progress of the scholar has been unsatisfactory.

7. Payments

The payment of the scholarship should be made half yearly.

8. Continuation of the scholarship for each academic year will be conditional upon:

8.1 the scholar successfully passing eight courses in each academic year; and

8.2 the student registering in their stated course of study at Lincoln University in the first semester of each year of tenure.

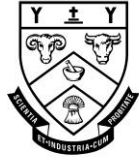
9. The Vice-Chancellor may in consultation with the Lincoln University Scholarship Committee may relax or modify the application of any of these regulations in special circumstances or in order to avoid hardship to any recipient.
