

LINCOLN UNIVERSITY

CENTENNIAL TRUST TRAVEL AWARDS

Lincoln University's relationships with overseas universities provide an excellent opportunity for students to gain international experience as part of their degree studies. The Lincoln University Centennial Trust established this award to support students participating in a recognised exchange who are undertaking degrees relevant to agriculture and land use in New Zealand.

Regulations

1. Name

The award shall be known as the Lincoln University Centennial Trust Travel Award.

2. Number/Value

Awards are available at a maximum value of NZ\$3,000.

3. Eligibility

The award shall be open to any student who

- 3.1 qualifies to participate in an overseas exchange programme sanctioned by Lincoln University, and
- 3.2 is registered as a full time student in an agricultural or land based degree at Lincoln University

4. Selection Criteria

The criteria for selection shall be as follows:

- 4.1 Academic merit
- 4.2 Relevance of an exchange to their proposed degree
- 4.3 Financial need, where candidates are comparable in other respects
- 4.4 A positive ambassador for Lincoln University and New Zealand travelling overseas.

Note: On return from exchange a report is required to be sent to the Centennial Trust outlining the exchange experience. Submission of this report indicates permission is granted for publication on the Centennial Trust's website, www.lincolnuniversityfoundation.org.nz.

The report should cover the following information:

- what has been learnt from the exchange experience and how does that translate into the candidate's planned career in agriculture in New Zealand.
- How can the exchange experience advance agriculture and land related interests within New Zealand.

5. Selection Committee

The awards shall be made by the Lincoln University Centennial Trust Chair on the recommendation of a selection committee which shall comprise:

- The Convenor of the Lincoln University Scholarships Committee, or nominee,
- Two representatives from the Lincoln University Centennial Trust, or nominees,
- The Senior Academic Adviser for Exchange Students, or nominee.

6. Tenure

The period of tenure shall be a maximum of one year.

7. Co-tenure

The award shall be tenable with any other scholarship, award or bursary. Applicants who are experiencing financial hardship may be given preference over those who have secured additional funding.

8. Review of Progress

The award may be terminated by the Centennial Trust at any time on either, receipt of a report from the Scholarships Committee that the conduct or progress of the recipient has been unsatisfactory, premature withdrawal from the Exchange Programme, in which case the award may be proportionally granted to the recipient.

9. Applications

Application forms are available from the Scholarships website, www.lincoln.ac.nz/scholarships and must be received by 4.30 pm on 31 March and 31 October each year.
