LINCOLN UNIVERSITY

OVERSEAS EXCHANGE AWARD

Regulations

1. Purpose

This scholarship was established as the American Exchange Scholarship in 1992 to encourage participation in the American Exchange Programme. In 1997 it was amended and renamed to encourage participation in all exchanges endorsed by Lincoln University.

The award shall be known as the Overseas Exchange Award.

2. Number/Value

The value of each award shall normally be \$2,000 but a greater or lesser sum may be granted. The sum available for disposal shall be determined by the selection committee. The awards may be granted biannually and may be shared by two or more candidates.

3. Eligibility

The award shall be open to any student who qualifies to participate in an Overseas Exchange Programme sanctioned by Lincoln University.

4. Selection Criteria

The criteria for selection shall be as follows:

- 4.1 Academic merit
- 4.2 Leadership skills
- 4.3 Financial need, where candidates are comparable in other respects.

5. Selection Committee

The awards shall be made by the Vice Chancellor on the recommendation of a selection committee which shall comprise:

- The Convenor of the Lincoln University Scholarships Committee, or nominee,
- The Director International or nominee

6. Tenure

The period of tenure shall be a maximum of one year.

7. Co-tenure

The award shall be tenable with any other scholarship, award or bursary.

8. Review of Progress

The award may be terminated by the Council at any time on either, receipt of a report from the Scholarships Committee that the conduct or progress of the recipient has been unsatisfactory, or premature withdrawal from the Exchange Programme, in which case the award may be proportionately granted to the recipient.

9. Applications
