

Regulations

1. Purpose

The North Canterbury Wine Growers Association Award was established in 2019 to support a current student who is enrolled in a postgraduate programme at Lincoln University which will be of benefit to this region.

2. Number/Value

One award will be offered annually to a current full time student at Lincoln University. The inaugural value of the scholarship is \$ 2,000.

3. Eligibility

- a. Applicants must be current full time students registered in an applicable programme of study at the start of the semester immediately following the award.
- b. Applicants can be New Zealand Citizens or Permanent Residents or International Students.

4. Selection Criteria

The criteria for selection will be:

- a. Academic Merit
- b. Evidence of a planned activity or research in support of and of benefit to the Canterbury wine industry

5. Selection Committee

The scholarship shall be awarded based on a recommendation of a selection committee which shall comprise:

- a. The convenor of the Scholarships Committee, or nominee
- b. A representative of the Faculty of Viticulture and Oenology or nominee, and
- c. A representative from North Canterbury Wine Growers Association.

The selection committee may request the applicant to attend an interview as part of the selection process and give a short presentation to the selection committee outlining how their research will be of benefit to the North Canterbury Wine Growers Association. The selection committee may refrain from making an award if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.

6. Tenure

- a. The award is tenable for a maximum of one year.
- b. The award is tenable with any other scholarship, award or bursary.

7. Review of Progress

- a. The successful applicant will be invited to do a short presentation at a function later in the year.
- b. If the University, at any time, is not satisfied that the scholar is diligently pursuing his or her studies; or is not complying with the conditions of the award; or is not making satisfactory progress, then the Selection Committee may suspend or terminate this award.

Note: Upon successful completion of the qualification there is a possibility of an internship should the opportunity become available.

8. Deferral of study

No deferment is available for this award.

9. Payment

This award will be paid in two instalments to the recipient. The first instalment (\$1,500) will be paid at the commencement of the academic year following receipt of the award. The final instalment (\$500) will be awarded to the recipient at the function towards the end of the year.

Send only copies that have been certified by a J.P, a solicitor, or a staff member in the university registry. **Unless specifically requested, please do not send a curriculum vitae.** Lincoln University accepts no responsibility to return original documents.

Please do not put your application into any sort of folder. Simply attach all pages with ONE staple in the top left hand corner or scan and email the application. All pages should be A4 size.
