



# Professor Barry Dent Scholarship and International Exchange



#### **Background**

This prestigious international exchange programme was established in recognition of Professor Barry Dent and his unique career in Farm Management and Agribusiness. Professor Barry Dent's career has taken him and his family around the world. While in New Zealand, Barry Dent, was Professor of Farm Management and Rural Valuation at Lincoln College and became Director of the Agribusiness and Economics Research Unit (AERU). Professor Dent made a significant contribution to research and teaching at Lincoln, later returning to the UK. After a period at the University of Edinburgh, he became Principal of the Royal Agricultural College in Cirencester. Both Lincoln College and the Royal Agricultural College now hold university status. This scholarship and international exchange honours Barry's career which incorporated both Lincoln University and the Royal Agricultural University. It is hoped that future recipients of this scholarship will benefit from the experience of an international exchange.

The International Exchange provides an excellent opportunity for students to gain overseas experience as part of their degree studies. It is hoped they will form networks for their future jobs and career and help forge a stronger relationship between the two institutions. The international exchange will support students undertaking degrees relevant to agriculture and land use in both NZ and the UK.

### Regulations

#### 1. Purpose

The Professor Barry Dent Scholarship was established in 2023 to support a student from Lincoln University to study for a semester at the Royal Agricultural University in the UK.

The Scholar shall travel from Lincoln University to the Royal Agricultural University to experience learning, agricultural practices, and cultural experiences.

#### 2. Number / Value

One scholarship will be offered annually to a full-time student studying at Lincoln University.

- a. The annual value of the scholarship is £3000.
- b. The scholarship provides a contribution towards:
  - International flights
  - Travel insurance
  - Modest stipend
- c. The student is to pay normal fees to their home university.
- d. Accommodation is mutually provided by each institution.
- e. Scholars may choose to extend their stay abroad outside of the Universities' semesters, but any additional travel, accommodation or subsistence costs during that time shall not be covered by the Gift.

#### 3. Eligibility

- a. The award shall be open to any student who qualifies to participate in an overseas exchange programme and is registered as a full-time student in an agricultural degree at Lincoln University.
- b. The Exchange shall be open to students in any second or third year of study in Agriculture or related subject areas.
- c. Course work is mutually credited back into a student's degree between the two institutions.
- d. Normal student visa requirements apply.

#### 4. Selection Criteria

The criteria for selection will be based on:

- a. Academic merit
- b. Relevance of an exchange to their current degree
- c. Financial need, where candidates are comparable in other respects
- d. The successful candidate agrees
  - To be a positive ambassador for Lincoln University and the Royal Agricultural University and in representing NZ and the UK overseas,

 To submit a brief report at the end of the exchange on learnings and experience, along with a profile and photo for marketing purposes.

#### 5. Selection Committee

The scholarship shall be awarded based on a recommendation of a selection committee which shall comprise:

- a. Vice-Chancellor or nominee,
- b. Convenor of the Lincoln University Scholarships Committee or nominee.
- c. A representative from Lincoln University International Team or nominee,
- d. Faculty representative or nominee,

The committee may request the applicant attend an interview in person or by video call as part of the selection process.

The panel may refrain from making an award if it finds no candidate adequately meets the selection criteria.

#### 6. Tenure

The period of tenure shall be a maximum of 6 months from the start of Semester 2.

The award shall be tenable with any other scholarship, award, or bursary.
