

Rakaia Island Scholarship

Rakaia Island Ltd is a large-scale family-owned dairy farm near Southbridge, mid- Canterbury. Converted from bare land in 1994, the property has been extensively developed and now comprises 4 dairy sheds and a dairy support unit over a total area of 1800ha.

Rakaia Island is pleased to offer an annual scholarship of \$4000 to a promising student who is either a) studying a Diploma in Agriculture, intending to continue into a Diploma in Farm Management OR b) a student who is intending to enter the third year of a Bachelor of Agriculture, Bachelor of Commerce (Agriculture) OR a Bachelor of Agricultural Science degree at Lincoln University.

ELIGIBILITY

To apply, the applicant must:

• be a full-time student registered in either the second year of a Bachelor of Agriculture, Bachelor of Commerce (Agriculture) or Bachelor of Agricultural Science.

OR

- be studying a Diploma in Agriculture, intending to continue with a Diploma in Farm Management.
- provide evidence of course costs for the coming year.
- be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident.
- complete and return this application form by 30th April 2024.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The decision to grant a scholarship will be based on the following criteria:

- Academic merit
- Evidence of interest in New Zealand agriculture (preference may be given to candidates with a particular interest in dairy farming)
- Personal profile

The successful applicant will have their course fees up to the value of \$4000 funded by Rakaia Island for the relevant academic year.

SELECTION PANEL

All eligible applications will be considered by a selection panel comprising two Directors of Rakaia Island Ltd. The selection panel may ask the short-listed applicants to attend an interview as part of the selection process. Selection will be made by the Board from the recommendations of the panel. The selection committee may refrain from awarding a scholarship if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE AND AWARD ANNOUNCEMENT

The deadline for submissions is 30th April 2024. Any applications submitted after this date will not be considered. The successful applicant will be announced during the month of June.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- a. The scholarship is awarded for one academic year only.
- b. The scholarship will be awarded upon successful completion of Semester 2 courses.
- c. The scholarship can be tenable with any other scholarship, bursary or award.
- d. You will be encouraged to take advantage of an opportunity to work for Rakaia Island over the summer holidays, however there is no obligation to accept a position.
- e. The panel respects the confidential nature of all information provided by applicants.
