THE SOUTH ISLAND AGRICULTURAL FIELD DAYS INC. SCHOLARSHIPS

REGULATIONS

The South Island Agricultural Field Days are a biennial event held at 1191 Courtenay Road, Kirwee. The Field Days began in 1951 and have grown to become one of the South Islands' largest agricultural fields days. Traditionally the field days have been organised and run by the Christchurch District Young Farmers Clubs, however since 2003 the field days are now organised and run by the South Island Agricultural Field Days Society Inc. (SIAFD).

One of the primary objectives of the field days has been to provide members of the Young Farmers Club with an opportunity to develop their leadership and management skills. The SIAFD continues to aim to achieve this objective and seeks to provide opportunities for members of NZYF to further their education and improve their skills and knowledge in relation to farming.

1. Purpose

Two of the South Island Agricultural Field Days Inc. scholarships are awarded for the purpose of encouraging and supporting members of the New Zealand Federation of Young Farmers Clubs studying full time at Lincoln University.

A new scholarship in 2024 is awarded to one non-NZYF member who is currently undertaking a full-time course of study in agriculture at Lincoln University, or who will be commencing a full-time course of study the year immediately following application.

2. Number

Three scholarships are available in total.

Up to two scholarships are available each year to full time students at Lincoln University who are members of the New Zealand Federation of Young Farmers Clubs (NZYF).

One scholarship will be available to a NZYF member from the Christchurch District of NZYF, and one to any other NZYF member, including other members from the Christchurch District. The selection committee may award more than two scholarships in any one year by jointly awarding either one or both scholarships to more than one applicant.

An additional scholarship is available each year to one non-NZYF member who is currently undertaking a full-time course of study in agriculture at Lincoln University, or who will be commencing a full-time course of study in the year immediately following application.

3. Eligibility

NZYF members who are currently undertaking a full-time course of study at Lincoln University, or who will be commencing a full-time course of study in the year immediately following application.

Non-NZYF members who are currently undertaking a full-time course of study in agriculture at Lincoln University, or who will be commencing a full-time course of study in the year immediately following application.

4. Tenure

The period of the scholarship is one year. Previous or current holders of this scholarship may apply for the award in a subsequent year.

5. Value

The value of each scholarship will be up to a maximum of \$2,500. The maximum value of the scholarships in any one year will be \$7,500. The scholarship will be credited against the successful applicants' course fees.

6. Co-Tenure

The scholarship shall be tenable with any other scholarship, bursary or award unless the conditions of the other award preclude it.

7. Selection Committee

The scholarships may be awarded by a selection committee of up to three members comprising:

- (i) Up to two representatives of the SIAFD Inc., and
- (ii) The convenor of the Lincoln University Scholarships Committee or nominee.

8. Selection Criteria

The criteria for selection will be:

- (i) leadership potential
- (ii) academic merit
- (iii) involvement in NZYF (for two out of the three scholarships), and
- (iv) the relevance of the applicants course of study and intended career to the primary sector.

9. Applications

Application forms are available from the Lincoln University Website www.lincoln.ac.nz/scholarships or the Scholarships Office, Lincoln University, with whom applications close on 31 October.

These regulations take effect from 8 May 2024.
