- The bursary is tenable for a maximum of three years and may be held concurrently with other scholarships or bursaries.
- A wide interpretation will be given to the relative course of study and would include agriculture, engineering, science, veterinary science, accounting, marketing, computer science, food technology and management.
- The successful person will be selected by representatives of Alliance Group.
- The company may refrain from making an award if it finds no candidate of sufficient merit.
- Successful recipients may be offered the opportunity to enter the Alliance Group Graduate Programme after completion final year of study.

To apply for this Bursary, you must meet the following criteria:

- The parents / primary carers of the Shareholder applicant must be actively supplying AGL.
- You may be entering any year of study
- Enrolled for a full-time course of study at a University or other agreed establishment within New Zealand.
